# Youth & Child Program Descriptions

## Monkey Madness (3-5yrs)

Does your little monkey have loads of energy after dinner? If so, join this evening program where they can burn off their fuel just in time for bed.

## • Little Artists (5-8yrs)

Arts and Crafts for an entire hour! This is a structured program that will encourage the little artists in your young ones. Make sure to wear old clothes and bring your creativity. It could be quite messy, but a lot of fun!

## • Youth Floor Hockey (10-14 yrs)

This is a great way to develop your skills in a non-competitive atmosphere. Floor hockey for ages 10-14 will be supervised but not structured. It is a great way to meet kids in the neighbourhood. Bring your plastic hockey sticks, water bottle and join the fun! This program will need parent supervision. A parent rotation will be scheduled on registration night. Maximum of 12 players per session.

## • **Painting** (9+)

This course will suit both beginners and advanced students. Develop your artistic skills while learning various drawing and painting techniques.

## • **Dog sitting course** (Gr.5-8)

The course is hosted by *It's a Dog's Life* and allows you to learn basic principles and practical techniques for dog sitting. There are 3 instructors and 3 dogs for 10 registrants. Once you complete the one evening class, you will become a certified dog sitter!
